- 5. What do these names mean for you today?
- 6. How would you define "great joy" and "peace"?
- 7. What steps would you suggest to someone who, knowing the Lord Jesus, has lost peace?
- 8. Who do you know in your life who is lacking peace and how may you best help them?
- 9. What do the shepherds model to us in their response to the announcement?
- 10. How will others know that you have received this peace from God?
